

# **SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

## **READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE YOU START USING TRAMPOLINE:**

**It is the responsibility of the owner or the trampoline supervisor to insure that all users of this trampoline are adequately informed of all warnings and safety instructions.**

The trampoline safety net is designed solely as a safety device, to significantly reduce the frequency of the trampoline users falling off or being ejected outside of the trampoline. You must not intentionally rebound off or crash into the poles or netting and you must not kick, cut or climb on or hang from the Safety net.

The trampoline safety net is not designed to prevent injuries associated with unsafe use of the trampoline, or associated with more advanced skills like flips, somersaults, or acrobatic maneuvers. Likewise, the trampoline safety net will not eliminate the user from having contact with the springs, frame, or other parts of a trampoline.

Each user of this device must also read and understand all of the warnings, precautionary statements, instructions, and use recommendations from manufacturer of the trampoline to which this trampoline safety net will be attached. The trampoline safety net does not replace the need for supervision by a responsible, knowledgeable adult.

## **ALWAYS FOLLOW THESE RULES WHEN USING THE TRAMPOLINE SAFETY NET:**

- Inspect the Trampoline safety net before each use. Make sure the webbing elastics and bungee cords are attached properly and are in good condition. Inspect the netting to make sure there are no broken or worn spots. Test the condition of the net by pulling on it in various locations around the Trampoline safety net. Make sure that all safety caps, foam padding, and other parts are properly secured and are not cracked or worn. Discontinue use of the Trampoline safety net immediately until any damaged or worn parts are replaced and properly adjusted.
- Remove all jewelry and hair clips before jumping on a trampoline fitted with a Trampoline safety net.
- Wear smooth clothing free of protrusions, hooks, loops, or buttons that might get caught when coming in contact with the netting, elastics, or other parts of the safety net. Do not wear clothing with hoods or drawstrings when jumping inside the Trampoline safety net.
- Only allow one person to use overlapping entrance at the same time.
- Allow only one user on the trampoline at the time.
- Never try skills without proper supervision, training and spotting.
- Do not allow individuals to jump in the Trampoline safety net without proper supervision.
- Children should always be supervised and observed by a responsible, knowledgeable adult.
- Never attempt to jump over the Trampoline safety net. Doing so may result in severe injury or death.
- Do not allow individuals under the influence of alcohol or drugs to use a trampoline or the Trampoline safety net.
- Never attempt to crawl underneath the Trampoline safety net. Severe injury or strangulation may result, especially for the children.
- When exiting the Trampoline safety net, do not jump off the edge of the trampoline. Always sit on the edge, then carefully lower your body onto the ground.
- Do not attach other apparatus to the Trampoline safety net unless it is Akrobat-approved device. Any additional safety net accessory that you may attach to the Trampoline safety net must be attached and used only in accordance with the instructions for such accessory.
- Keep the trampoline and Trampoline safety net in a secure location where it will not be subjected to unauthorized use.
- Always wear socks or gym slippers when using the trampoline safety net.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRAMPOLINE FIBERGLASS SAFETY NET


### 1. Install the trampoline



Put the Junction part on the leg of the trampoline by lifting the trampoline frame and placing it on the Extension leg. Junction part has two parts. Wider part fits the leg; more narrow part will support the pole. Turn the junction part so that squeezed end is facing up.




- Put a plastic caps on the steel poles and cover them with pvc sleeves. At the end hook the cap with webbing.
- Place poles into junction parts as shown on the photo. Sleeves have Velcro belts at the end to close sleeves around junction parts.




- Now you've installed all the poles, take the net and fiberglass poles.

Connect fiberglass poles with aluminium connection parts.




- It takes two people to install the net. One person at each side fills a top of the net with fiberglass poles. Slide one pole at the time and connect it with the next one.



- When you have poles on each side of the net, push them together to make a circle and join them with aluminium connection part.





- Once the top frame is well connected, lift it above the poles and place it on plastic caps. Make sure to put entrance between two poles. On the shorter distance between poles is better.



8. Bottom part of the net will be attached at the poles and between poles. Netting between the poles attach with elastic toggle to the trampoline frame. Put the elastic through eyelets and section in the frame pad. Attach it to the trampoline frame.



9. Attaching net at the pole. Put the elastic through eyelets and hook it to the bottom part of the junction part.
